Thank you for your inquiry into Drive Tek's Youth Driver Education Program. Please check the enclosed schedule for the time and location of your choice. The student will set up their driving schedule with the instructor during the first class.

Classes are held at Ankeny High School, Ames High School, Newton High School, and William Penn University in Oskaloosa. In Des Moines the class locations are Upper Iowa University and Brody Middle School.

All of the scheduled classes are state certified and include 32 hours of classroom instruction, with 4 hours of instruction covering alcohol and drug abuse as it relates to the driving task and 6 hours of actual on-street driving.

The cost of the course is \$350. \$100 registration fee is due with your registration. The remaining \$250 is due by the fifth class session.
